

TOWN OF LAGRANGE

ORDINANCE NO. 2012-09-17

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of the Town of LaGrange:

SECTION I

Upon investigation by the Traffic Safety Committee and recommendation to the Board of Trustees of the Town of LaGrange, Indiana, the following amendment of the Town of LaGrange Ordinances is hereby deemed to be necessary to effectuate and preserve the safety of automobiles and their use upon the streets of the Civil Town of LaGrange. It has been determined that certain parking zones posted on LaGrange Town roads are unreasonable and that the following parking zones are hereby declared to be reasonable:

SECTION II

In the Town of LaGrange, Indiana, there shall be no parking on the west side of Union Street from the alley south of the grocery store parking lot to the Hawpatch Street intersection.

SECTION III

The Town of LaGrange is authorized and directed to post signs, paint signs on pavement, or otherwise noted by vehicle operators of the existence of this ordinance. Said employees are further directed to effectuate the provisions of this ordinance as soon as same can be done.

SECTION IV

The penalties imposed by the Town of LaGrange Ordinance which applies to violations of Ordinance No. 2012-09-17 shall also apply to violation of this ordinance.

SECTION V

If any provision of this ordinance shall be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, this invalidity shall not affect any other provisions of this ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provision and, for this purpose, the provisions of this ordinance are declared to be severable.

SECTION VI

This ordinance shall become effective upon promulgation according to law.
