Reported that the Ladder Truck has passed all pumping tests.

Reported that the two firefighters that were involved in a 'horse play' accident have been suspended for 60 days. They will be permitted to attend the Fire Dept Christmas party.


Member G. Kenner made a motion, seconded by Member Hoover to allow claims. Motion carried
