ORDINANCE #2012-02-06B

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A PROCEDURE FOR
OFF-SITE FOOD SALES BENEFITTING
CHARITABLE/SCHOLASTIC GROUPS

WHEREAS, the LaGrange Town Board has received complaints from members of the general public and Focus LaGrange as concerns the operation of off-site BBQ and other food sales utilizing county property in and around the courthouse for charitable purposes.

WHEREAS, residents and Focus LaGrange have requested the Board to ascertain that proper insurance coverage is available for the entities performing this function, and that the sponsoring entity is in fact a not-for-profit scholastic or charitable entity benefitting local individuals.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that off-site BBQ or similar food/concession sales shall be permitted in the town of LaGrange only after procuring the appropriate permit.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that in order to procure a permit for off-site BBQ or food/concession sales, it must be shown that the sponsoring entity is a not-for-profit scholastic, charitable, or similar entity, that it has a local LaGrange aspect to it, that the benefits of such activity will be to and for individuals in or around the town and county of LaGrange, and that either the sponsoring entity or food/concession provider has insurance in the appropriate amounts against liability arising out of said function.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the charge for said permit shall be \$0.00.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that said functions shall be limited to once per week, on either a Friday or Saturday, such at the choice of the sponsoring entity, and being limited to one sponsored activity per week, on a first come, first served basis. In other words, there are 52

available permitted functions in a calendar year.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED the permitted event shall occur on a rotating basis, rotating between 1) the LaGrange Town Hall, 2) the east side of the courthouse square, or 3) Schlemmer's Hardware parking lot. Such rotation shall occur on a weekly basis.

THIS ORDINANCE SHALL TAKE AFFECT UPON PROMULGATION ACCORDING TO LAW.
